Pair of Sphinxes.

Imposing stone sculptures in the image of a Sphinx and a Sphinx.

Represented lying down, they wear a Nemes, the headdress of the pharaohs from the Old Kingdom to the Ptolemaic period.

Symbol of power and vigilance in ancient Egypt, these mythological sculptures represented a lion with a human head. 17th century.

Limestone.

Each statue is made up of two blocks.
